Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know we are holding our Harvest Festival Service at Teynham Church, weather permitting, on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> September at 10.00am. For Harvest this year we would like to join the local churches in their support of The Family Foodbank, which operates in Swale (as well as other areas of Kent). The Family Foodbank supports families in urgent need of help with food boxes to see them through a time of crisis.

For our Harvest Festival, therefore we are asking for children to bring in items for the Foodbank which asks for:

- Packets of pasta, Jars of pasta sauce,
- Baked Beans and tins of Spaghetti in tomato sauce,
- Rice,
- Tinned fruit,
- Porridge Oats,
- Packets of cereal,
- UHT Milk,
- Tinned meat/fish,
- Tinned vegetables,
- Jars of jam,
- Tea/coffee, and Sugar.
- In addition nappies and wet wipes are asked for to place in boxes for families with babies.

These can be brought into school where there is a box in Reception or can be brought to the Church on the Day.

The Box will continue to be available in School following Harvest so that contributions to the Foodbank can be brought in to school at anytime.
